Makeshift Sketchbook

In addition to class handouts, your manilla folder will house your “sketchbook.” We will have days this year where you will have short drawing assignments and these pieces will be kept in your folder.

Folder PICK UP and Folder DROP OFF

Each day you enter the room, you will drop off your books and other “stuff” on the shelves in the foyer. The foyer is the room you enter first coming into the art room. We have limited space so please do not bring these items in our studio space.

As you enter the room you will pick up your folder from the “FOLDER PICK UP” box. When you exit the room you will place your folders in the “FOLDER DROP OFF” box.

Designing your Folder

This year we are using plain old manilla folders - but we will take some time today to jazz them up and help give me insight into who you are as an artist.

Write your name in block letters...create a design or drawing. It's up to you how you decorate your folder.
